Advanced Medical Life Support

Advanced Medical Life Support (AMLS), is an educational program sponsored by the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) and endorsed by the National Association of EMS Physicians (NAEMSP). This program is designed for all areas of healthcare, both in hospital and out of hospital. The mission of the program is to promote competence of Healthcare Providers in the assessment and management of adult patients who experience medical emergencies. AMLS is the first course that offers a "think-outside-the-box" method of assessing and managing a patient in a medical crisis.

The AMLS Provider course is a 2 day (16hr) in depth study of medical emergencies for the adult patient. The course emphasizes a pragmatic approach and systematic format regarding patient assessment and management. It combines interactive scenario based lectures with hands on physical assessment of patients.

Precourse preparation is necessary for successful completion of the course, and includes access to the current AMLS Textbook.

Prerequisites: EMT-B, EMT-Paramedic, RN, PA, CRNP, Physicians with at least one year experience in clinical practice. This is a rapid paced, thought provoking class which will ensure that participants have the basic knowledge and experience on which the AMLS course is built. Participants must read the text and come to class prepared.

Successful completion of the program consists of the following:

- Attendance at both days of the course
- A score of 76% or better on the written exam final.
- Proficiency at the four assessment/evaluation stations:
 - o Dyspnea/Respiratory failure
 - o Chest Pain / Hypoperfusion
 - o Abdominal Pain / GI Bleed
 - o Altered Mental Status

Upon successful completion, an ATLS certification and card will be issued for a four year period.
